Welcome to Kelowna United FC 2009-2010 Player Evaluations!

The Kelowna United FC Board would like to take this time to give you a little overview of what you can expect if your son or daughter is selected to play with a Kelowna United Team. We also want to ensure you have access to all the information you may need to understand our program. We have created a Q & A on our website that provides you with information and it can be found at www.kelownaunited.com.

Once player evaluations are completed and teams selected, registration of players selected will commence. To this end, a non refundable deposit of \$200 is required at the third tryout session. If you are selected for the team, it will be cashed and if not, it will be destroyed. A team manager will be selected as soon as possible to collect all registration forms and balance of fees and hand them in to the Kelowna United Administrator. Collection of the remaining fees is in two instalments with **\$150 due Nov 30th, 2009** and the final **balance due Jan 31st, 2010**.

Fees are set at the first Board meeting following the AGM in Dec. A sample budget of what you can expect for the year is attached. It will vary team to team depending on tournaments decided on.

What can you expect from the Kelowna United FC Soccer Season?

The season runs from November 1st to Oct 31st with TOYSL League games being played from April to June. We have teams from Calgary and the USA wanting to come to play exhibition games in the Fall and early Spring and we will be arranging these as well as teams are encouraged to enter tournaments to compliment their season and competitiveness. There are many Thanksgiving tournaments being held in Oct at the Coast and Kamloops is holding a small Thanksgiving one as well. Details will be posted on the website.

During the fall and winter, teams are encouraged to practice on their own with some specific skill camps being offered. Goalkeeper clinics will also be held again this season. Once League games start, practices will be twice per week with weekly games held on Sundays and maybe midweek depending on age groups and amount of teams in your group.
